

Caregiver Training Unit Netlink Hints

The Child Welfare Partnership offers both daytime and evening distance training open to staff and community partners on a monthly basis. Participants can join in from their homes using their Internet connected computer and speakers or headset.

What is Netlink Training?

NetLink is an interactive distance delivery training option that allows participants to receive training in their homes, or at their local branch if a group site is being hosted. The training is delivered via the internet in a Virtual Classroom called iLinc. This software works best with an internet connected Windows computer and either speakers or a headset. While wifi does work, a hard wired Ethernet connection is best.


How Do I Sign Up for iLearn?

Go to the iLearn Website: <https://ilearn.oregon.gov/>

- If it's your first visit, or if you've created a Learning Center profile after June 24th 2016, you'll have to use the Create Account link, on the top right of the ilearn website, to create a new account (see below).
